AIM

To exchange information with a partner about a group of managers.

GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS

Present simple questions

VOCABULARY

managing director, financial director, marketing manager, sales manager, production manager, personnel manager, IT (Information Technology) manager, salary, company car, office

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for each pair of students and cut it in two as indicated. Try to make sure there are bilingual dictionaries available.

TIME

15 to 20 minutes

PROCEDURE

1 Put the following on the board:

JOB:

2 Elicit questions to fit the gaps in the information:

What's John Smith's/Jane Brown's job? What's the (financial director's) name? What's his/her salary? What make is his/her car?

3 Drill the questions for pronunciation and complete the information with the students' suggestions.

4 Put the students into pairs to practise the questions and answers.

5 Give out the worksheets, one section - A or B - to each student in each pair.

6 Allow a minute or two for reading and checking vocabulary.

7 Get the students, in pairs, to ask and answer questions to complete the tables.

FOLLOW-UP

Ask each student to write a description of one of the people in the table. For example: *Mark Brown is the managing director. His salary is...*
