












# Solutions for English Teaching

#### **ACTIVITY**

Pairwork: writing, speaking

#### **AIM**

To complete some sentences as if you were your partner.

#### **GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS**

Second conditional to talk about a situation which is unlikely or about which you're unsure

#### **VOCABULARY**

General

#### **PREPARATION**

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student in the class.

#### TIME

20 to 30 minutes

#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Ask the students to work in pairs.
- 2. Give one copy of the worksheet to each student in the class.
- 3. Tell the students that they are going to complete the sentences on their worksheet as if they were their partner. They should not let their partner see what they are writing
- 4. When they have finished, they should take turns reading the completed sentences to their partner and ask for their comments.
