

**ACTIVITY** 

Pairwork: reading, speaking

AIM

To play a game of *Snap!* by making correct collocations.

**GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS** 

Collocation

**VOCABULARY** 

Items of shopping

**PREPARATION** 

Make two copies of the worksheet for every two or three students in the class and cut out the cards as indicated.

TIME

10 to 15 minutes

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. Tell the students that they are going to play a card game called *Snap!*
- **2.** Ask the students to work in pairs or groups of three and explain how to play the game using the instructions below.
- **3.** The students are ready to play the game. While they are playing, go around to each group and check to see that they are playing correctly.

## **HOW TO PLAY THE GAME**

- 1. Player A shuffles the cards and deals them all out equally to all the players.
- 2. Players must hold their cards in a pile face down so that they can't see them.
- **3.** Player A puts his/her top card face up on the table.
- **4.** Player B puts his/her top card face up on top of Player A's card.
- **5.** If the two cards go together, the first player to shout *Snap!* picks up all the cards. For example, if one card has the

- words *a bottle of* and the other card has a picture of a bottle of wine or a bottle of perfume, they go together.
- **6.** If the two cards do not go together, the next player puts a card face up on top of the pile.
- Players continue putting down cards and shouting *Snap!* when two cards go together until they have used all their cards.
- **8.** The player with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
