

## **ACTIVITY**

Pairwork: speaking, writing

#### **AIM**

To write short advertisements for products.

## **GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS**

Describing objects

#### **VOCABULARY**

fast, well-made, traditional, comfortable, economical, casual, smart, useful, elegant, beautiful, cheap, exclusive, efficient, powerful, luxurious, modern

### **PREPARATION**

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student. Try to make sure there are some bilingual dictionaries available.

#### TIME

20 to 30 minutes

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1 Tell the students they are going to look at advertising language.
- 2 Give out the worksheets.
- **3** Ask the students to identify the pictures: *What's number 6?* etc.
- 4 Divide the class into pairs or small groups.
- 5 Ask them to look at the words at the bottom of the worksheet and decide which product(s) each word could describe. Allow 5 to 10 minutes. Circulate and monitor.
- **6** When most pairs have finished, reconvene the class to compare answers.
- 7 Divide the class into small groups.
- 8 Ask each group to choose a product.
- **9** Ask them to write the text for an advertisement for the product they have chosen. Circulate, helping with grammar and vocabulary.
- **10** As each group finishes, get them to put their advertisement up on the wall.
- 11 Let students circulate, reading each other's advertisements.
