ACTIVITY

Individual, pairwork: reading, speaking

AIM

To ask and answer questions about work.

GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS

Revision: present simple, adverbs of frequency, can for ability, giving directions, present continuous

VOCABULARY

computer programs

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

TIME

15 to 25 minutes

PROCEDURE

- 1 Tell the class you are going to give them a dictation consisting of ten questions.
- 2 Dictate the questions from the worksheet, saying each question twice.
- 3 Give out the worksheets and allow a couple of minutes for the students to check the dictation.
- 4 Ask how many sentences the students got right, working down in descending order: Who got all ten right? Who got nine? Eight?
- 5 Get the students to complete the You column. Circulate, helping with vocabulary.
- 6 Divide the class into pairs.
- 7 Tell the students they are going to ask each other the questions.
- 8 If necessary, drill the questions.
- 9 Get the students to ask each other the questions, noting the answers in the Your partner column.
- 10 When most pairs have finished, regroup the class and ask a few of the students to report back on their partners.
