

Joe and the Thieves

Age: Young Adult- Adult Level: Beginners, pre-int Length: 1 hour to 2 hours

Vocab: Basic words, past tense regulars and irregulars.

Focus: Listening and recounting a story. Writing a story from memory using the past tense.

- 1. Slowly read out the story to students. You might like to pre-teach the following vocab, *Thief, thieves, rope, remove, neck, amazed, curse, become, respect* and *naughty.* Make sure they understand what happens, this will be apparent if they smile. Go over any vocab they find difficult on the board.
- 2. When you are happy that students have understood ask them to recount it back to you. In order to avoid one person telling you the whole story again, have them take turns so that each student gets a go at telling a little bit of the story.
- 3. Now the difficult part. Get students to try and write down the story in their own words. This is very difficult for a lot of students, and they will have problems with sentence structure, spelling and the use of the past tense. Monitor how they are doing, offering advice and corrections.

You can use this lesson to assess what problems students have with written English, and concentrate on these areas in later lessons.

If your students are too basic to write the story for themselves you can always have them read it and answer the optional comprehension questions. (Answers 1.b 2.c 3.b 4.a 5.c)

This is also a great dictation lesson.
