Nico Rosberg retires five days after becoming Formula One world champion

9 February 2017

- 1 The Formula One racing driver Nico Rosberg has decided to retire from motor racing at the age of just 31. He announced his retirement five days after becoming Formula One world champion.
- Nico Rosberg was born in Wiesbaden, Germany in 1985, the son of a German mother and a Finnish father. His father, Keke Rosberg, was also a famous Formula One racing driver and won the world championship in 1982 for the Williams team.
- 3 Nico Rosberg learnt to drive when he was very young and began to compete in special races for children when he was six years old. He later drove in junior races and then did test drives for Williams in 2004. He joined the Williams Formula One team in 2006 but didn't win any races with that team. He joined the Mercedes team in 2010 and finally won his first race at the Chinese Grand Prix in 2012. Rosberg's win was the first for Mercedes since 1955.

- 4 Between 2013 and 2015, Rosberg won 13 Grand Prix races and was second in the drivers' championship in 2014 and 2015 behind the champion, his Mercedes teammate, the British driver Lewis Hamilton.
- 5 In 2016, there were 21 Grand Prix races. Rosberg won nine of those races, including the Russian, Belgian, German and Japanese races. Although Lewis Hamilton won 12 races, Rosberg won more points than him by finishing second or third more times. In the final race of 2016, the Abu Dhabi Grand Prix, Rosberg only had to finish second to become world champion. Hamilton won the race but Rosberg was second and became world champion for the first time.
- 6 Rosberg raced in a car with the same number as his father (number 6) and became the first German to win the world championship for a German team in a car with a German engine.
