

- In -gn or -gne at the end of a word, the g is always silent.
- In kn- at the beginning of a word, the k is always silent.
- In wr- at the beginning of a word, the w is always silent.
- In could, should and would, the I is always silent.
- In -st- in the middle of a word, the t is usually pronounced, but it is silent in some words.
