SLEEP IS BETTER THAN MEDICINE .

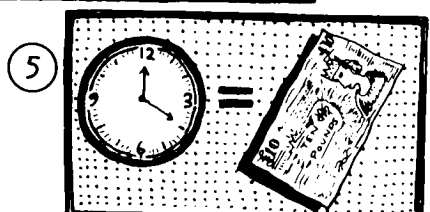
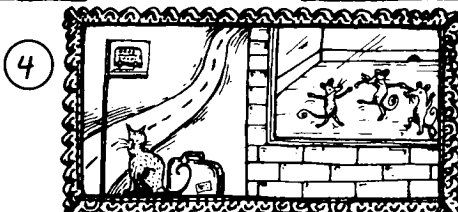
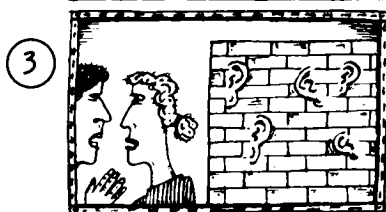
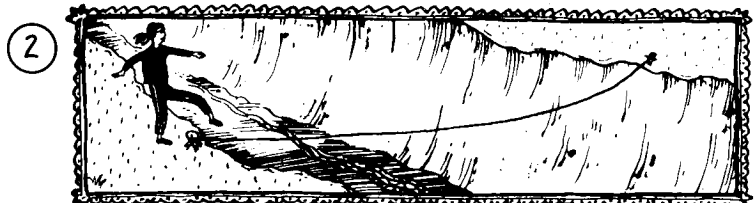
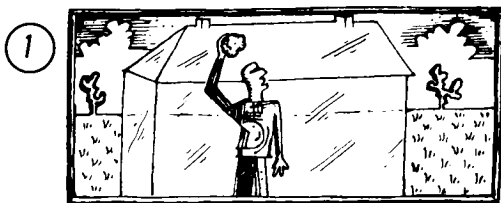

Elephant Jokes

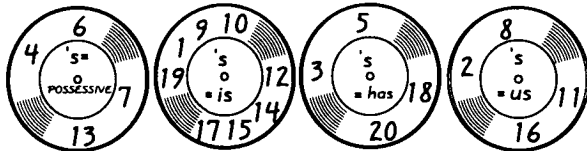
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- How does an elephant get down from a tree? – It sits on a leaf and waits for autumn.

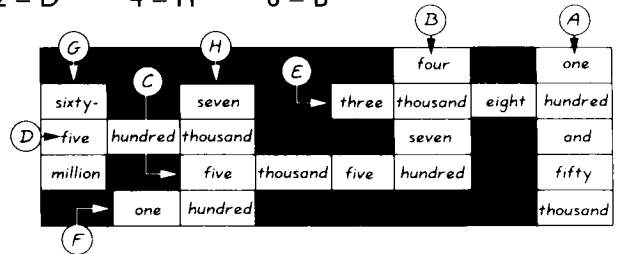
