Sniffer dog finds rhino horn worth more than one million dollars 7 February, 2019

- 1 There are five species of rhinoceros in the world and their numbers are slowly falling. In Asia, the Javan and Sumatran rhinos are extremely endangered. Only around 60 Javan rhinos still exist and there are only about 80 Sumatran rhinos. In India, there are just over 3,500 onehorned rhinos. The situation in Africa is better – there are over 5,000 black rhinos and more than 20,000 white rhinos. But the African rhinos are still endangered because of an illegal activity – poaching. About 1,000 rhinos a year are killed by poachers in South Africa.
- 2 Poachers kill rhinos to get their horns. Smugglers take the horns out of Africa and the horns are used to make powder. Powder made from rhino horns is used in traditional medicine, especially in China and Vietnam. It is very expensive, so poachers and smugglers can make a lot of money by killing rhinos and selling their horns illegally on the black market.

- 3 But the governments of countries like South Africa and Kenya are now taking action against the poachers and smugglers. They are training dogs to find rhino horns and other illegal products. In January, 2019, a sniffer dog at the international airport in Johannesburg found 116 kilograms of rhino horns. Smugglers were trying to put the rhino horns on a flight to Dubai but the dog, called Lizzy, found them. One hundred and sixteen kilograms of rhino horns is worth around \$1.3 million.
- 4 Poachers don't just kill rhinos. They also kill elephants. They kill them for their tusks, which they can sell as ivory on the black market. People mainly use ivory to make jewellery. In 2018, poachers killed 87 elephants in Botswana, a country north of South Africa.
