## Family chants

### Level 1 • Starter / Beginner +

Age: Primary (6-11)

Language aims: To read and recite chants about families, to write a chant about a family, to draw a picture to accompany the chant

Time: 20 minutes

Student grouping: Individuals

<u>Materials:</u> One copy of the worksheet per student; a sheet of A4 paper per student; the audio (downloaded in advance or played via onestopenglish)

Language focus: There are ... in my family; What about you?; Mother, father, brother, sister, grandmother, grandfather, etc

### **Transcript**

There are three in my family My father, my brother and me! What about you?

There are five in my family My father, my mother, my sister, my brother and me! What about you?

There are four in my family My mother, my grandmother, my sister and me! What about you?

#### **Procedure**

#### Step 1

Using a copy of the worksheet, elicit or introduce the language of families including father, mother, sister, brother, grandmother and grandfather. Point to yourself and say, 'There are three in my family. My mother, my sister and me. What about you Juan/ Mercedes?' Practise There are . . . in my family. What about you? Write this on the board.

#### Step 2

Give each child a copy of the worksheet ask them to read the chants about families.

#### Step 3

Play the audio.

#### Step 4

Ask the children to write their own family chant on a separate piece of paper. When they have finished they can draw a small picture of their family.

#### Step 5

Now let the children say their family chants as a chain around the class. It might help to sit or stand in a circle. As they say 'What about you?' they look at the next person in the circle.

## Follow-up activity

Create a chant poster for the wall and stick copies of some of the children's chants onto this.
