Groupwork: speaking

AIM

To try out challenges in teams and fill in a chart to show what members of the team can and can't do.

GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS

Can and could for ability

VOCABULARY

General

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for every three students in the class.

TIME

40 minutes

PROCEDURE

- 1 Ask the students to work in groups of three.
- 2 Give one copy of the worksheet to each group.
- Ask the three members of each group to write their names next to the first challenge on the worksheet.
- In their groups, the students take it in turns to try out the challenge and then tick the 'can' or 'can't' column next to their name according to whether they completed the task successfully or not.
- 5 The students repeat the procedure for all challenges in their groups and complete the chart.
- If one group finishes their challenges before the rest of the class, ask them to think of new challenges.
- When the groups have completed their worksheets, ask the students to **either**:
 - a) write a summary of what they could and couldn't do.

or

b) take it in turns to tell the class one thing they could do and one thing they couldn't do.
