ACTIVITY

Groupwork: reading, speaking

AIM

To identify six companies or products from six facts about each one.

GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS

Present and past simple

VOCABULARY

patents, to found (a company), to manufacture, to sell well, brand

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for each group of six students and cut it up as indicated

TIME

10-20 minutes

PROCEDURE

- Tell the students they are going to identify some famous companies and products from facts about them.
- **2** Divide the class into groups of six.
- Give each student in each group one of the cards from the worksheet. Each student should have a different card. If there are fewer than six students in the group, give some more than one card.
- Each group identifies the companies or products which the sentences on the cards refer to. There are six sentences about each of six companies and they are distributed throughout the six cards. Students may not show their cards to each other, but should read the sentences out or explain the facts in their own words.
 - You may want to write the names of the six companies on the board before they begin this stage.
- Go through the answers with the class, asking which sentences refer to which companies, and what else they know about the companies.
- 6 Ask them to dictate the sentences to you in a logical order and write them on the board.

FOLLOW-UP 1

Students write key facts about their own company, or another they know well, and pass them around the class for others to read.

FOLLOW-UP 2

Working in pairs, the students list what they think are the world's ten most famous products and companies.
