AIM

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student in the class.

TIME

20 minutes

PROCEDURE

1. Ask the class to imagine their life in ten years from now.
2. Ask the students to work in pairs.
3. Give one copy of the worksheet to each student in the class.
4. Ask them to imagine *their partner* ten years from now, and choose the predictions on their worksheet that are most appropriate for them. They should put their partner's name next to the predictions they have chosen. Point out that there are three blank spaces for students to write in any predictions they can think of that are not provided.
5. Ask the students to take turns reading their predictions to one another and commenting on them.

OPTION

Alternatively, give one copy of the worksheet to each student in the class, and ask them to put the name of a different student in the class next to each prediction. Then ask them to go around the class, reading out their predictions to one another.
