 c) I have to meet other person.

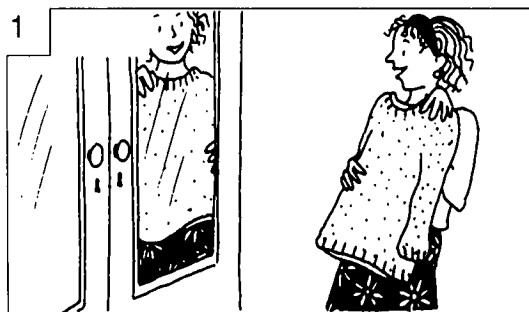
- 6 A:** Shall I order you a pizza?

 c) I'm afraid I won't have time.

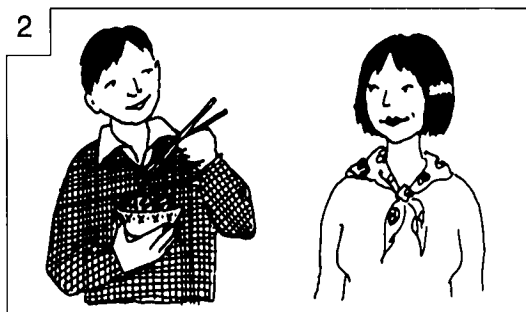

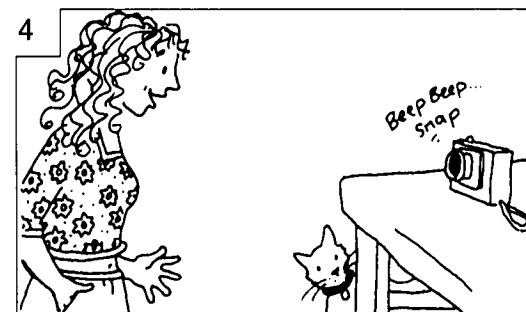
