Remember:

Most nouns make their plural by adding s to the singular (birds, sisters, sons, frogs, shadows). This includes nouns ending with a vowel + y (days).


Nouns ending with a consonant +y make their plural with ies (fly - flies).

Nouns ending with x, s, ch or sh make their plural with es (foxes).

Some nouns have irregular plurals (man - men).


