Subject: Music

Musical instruments

Objective: identifying musical instruments **Vocabulary:** *piano, violin, flute, drums, triangle, saxophone*

Introduction

You will probably find that your pupils have a varied knowledge of musical instruments. Some of them will only know those instruments they have worked with in their music classes, while others may have a wider knowledge.

Warm up

- Ask the pupils if any of them are learning how to play an instrument.
- Write the names of the instruments they say on the board. Ask individual pupils and then the class to mime how they play these instruments.
- Write the names of the instruments on slips of paper and hand them out.
- Ask pupils holding a slip of paper to stand up and mime their instrument. The rest of the class guesses which instrument it is.

Activity 1

• Pupils match the words and pictures.

Activity 2

- Tell pupils to look at the chart carefully.
- Ask questions, for example, *Can Rose play the violin? Can Max play the drums?*
- Pupils circle T or F on their worksheets.
- Ask *Is number 1 true or false?* Repeat with the other statements. Pupils correct their work.

Answers: 1-T; 2-F; 3-T; 4-T; 5-F

Activity 3

- Pupils complete the sentences for themselves.
- Ask volunteers to read their sentences out loud.

Project ideas

- Make a recording of different musical instruments and ask the pupils to identify them.
- Make a poster of an orchestra. Pupils find pictures of all the instruments and label them.
