Mingling puzzle: Past perfect and past simple by Jill Hadfield

Level: Upper Intermediate

Target age: Secondary/adult

Time needed: 20 minutes

Grammar objective: To practise the past

perfect and past simple

Materials: Clue cards

Summary: This is an accuracy-based mingling puzzle to practise the past perfect

and past simple.

Procedure

- 1. Copy and cut up a set of the clue cards for your class.
- Give a clue card to each student. There are 20 clue cards and you will need to use them all.
 If you have fewer than 20 students in your class, give some students two (adjacent) clue cards. If you have more than 20, put some students in pairs to share a card.
- 3. Tell students that some of the cards have information about John's day, some have information about Alice's day. At some point John and Alice met and decided to go out to dinner. The aim of the puzzle is to find out where John and Alice could have met each other.
- 4. To do this, students should:
- a. sort themselves into two groups: John's day and Alice's day;
- exchange information on their cards to arrange themselves in chronological order from the beginning of the day to the end;
- c. tell the other group about the events of the day and work out where Alice and John met.

Answer: They met at Susie and Tom's.
