B1+ Services: Being Illiterate in the Modern World

Summary: The text describes the situation of illiteracy around the world and how developing countries have been solving illiteracy.

Time: Approximately 40 minutes

Skills: Reading, Writing, Speaking

Language focus: Vocabulary

Materials needed: One worksheet per student

Reading

Encourage students to give possible answers to the question before reading the text. Have students read the text and answer the question. Ask them to compare their previous opinions with the information given.

Thinking
