

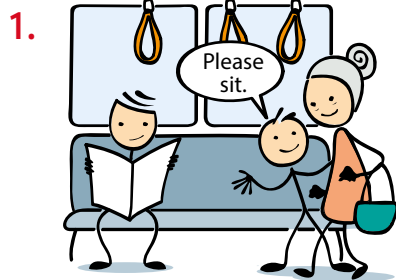

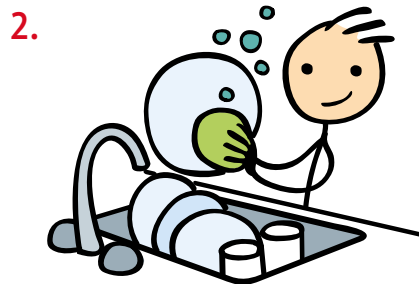

Later, he learned that 13 million children around the world did not have the glasses they needed. He started an organization called *Sight Learning*. The group collects used glasses and gives them to children all around the world who need them.




Christopher Nguyen likes making people happy. Almost every week, he plays piano at a center for seniors in Alameda, California. When he plays the piano, they all stop to listen. Christopher looks at people's faces to see how they are feeling. Then he chooses the kind of music to play. Usually, the seniors smile, and sometimes cry.




Melati and Isabel Wijsen are sisters from Bali, Indonesia. Bali is beautiful, but there is plastic trash on beaches, in rivers, and in the streets. The sisters started a group called *Bye Bye Plastic Bags*. They help people understand why plastic is bad for the planet. 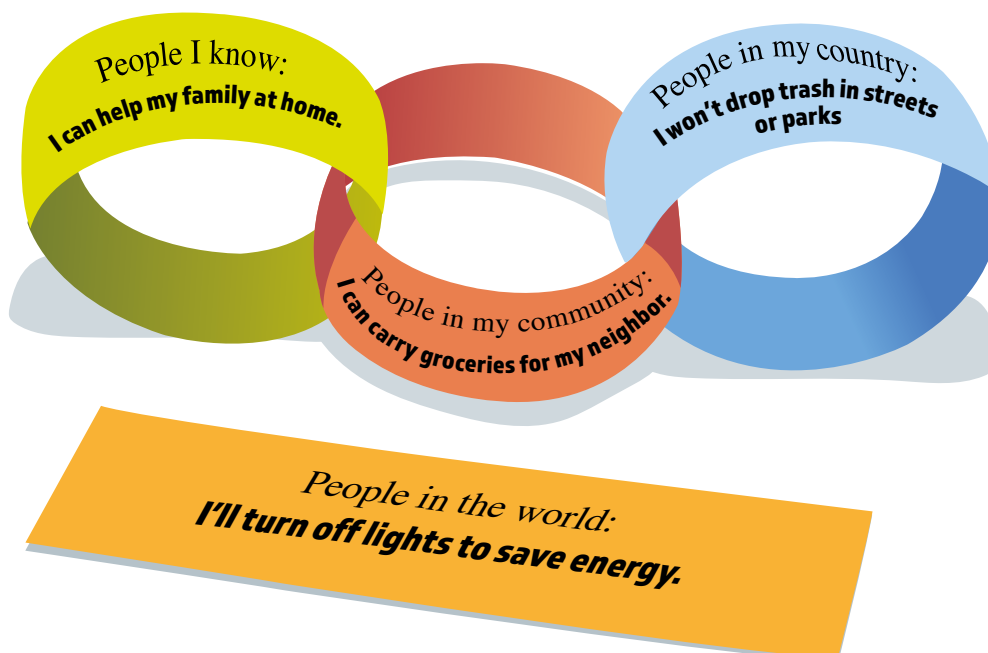
