What is an online comic creator? Extra information

An **online comic creator** tool allows you to create animated characters and short dialogues in cartoon-strip style.

You can usually choose a scene or a background for your comic and you can add simple props too. There are online tools that can also create animated comics.

Comics are usually made in the first person voice. This means that the writer has to imagine what the characters are saying and write it out in direct speech.

Online and animated comics can be a very creative form of written expression that can attract and entertain many audiences, especially to the younger generation.

They can be used to tackle difficult topics and are accessible for younger people.

- 1 Comic strips usually use direct speech in the first person.
