Let's discuss

A Read the text and answer the questions.

 Ask students to read the text and discuss the questions in pairs. Elicit some answers and discuss as a class.

Online quizzes. Extra information

An **online quiz** can be very easy to create because the online tool does all the work for you. Students should look at the question types while they are writing the questions so that they can focus on their answers.

Quizzes are useful for general knowledge but also for revision of class work, particularly if they are created by students themselves.

Let's analyse

- B Look at the example of an online quiz. Answer the questions in groups.
- Ask students to look at the quiz and discuss the questions in pairs or small groups.
- Make sure students notice that the quiz is not just general knowledge. It is testing a grammar point or a vocabulary area.

- 4 It should be quite easy to create because the online tools available do all the work for you. You only need to think of the questions and know the answers.
- Go online and type keywords to find websites that can help students create online guizzes.
- Try making a group quiz using suggestions from the class. Ask students what vocabulary or grammar point they want to use in the quiz. Make the quiz on screen.

Let's do it!

- This can be completed in class or as homework.
- Ask students to create a quiz based on one grammar point or vocabulary area they studied or learnt about in the past. They can do this individually or in small groups.
- Once you have all the links to the quizzes, use one lesson to view them all as a class. Students can do each other's quizzes and choose the best three.

TIPS!

Creating an online quiz

Before class, look for websites that allow you to create online quizzes for free, using different media types by typing "online guiz maker" into the search bar.

It is best if you practise on your chosen website in advance of the lesson, to make sure you understand its features and also to create a sample to demonstrate to your students.
