Spelling Bee Games Climbing the Ladder



How to play?

Students can use these activities to review vocabulary items or to prepare for a Spelling Bee. There are two versions of each activity: one for students to practice alone, and one they can do in pairs or groups.

Level: Starters (Pre A1 - A1)

Age: Children (Primary)

Time needed: 10 minutes

Aim: Practice Spelling Bee skills and review vocabulary related to a specific topic

or lesson

Skills: Spelling, Vocabulary, Listening

Materials needed: Worksheets

Warm-up Tips

Go over the alphabet with your students. You can do it first A to Z, then backwards, then vowels and consonants, etc. Variety will help students learn the letters better.

Individual Practice

- Choose a word and say it out loud. Students should write that word on the bottom step of the ladder.
- Write the word on the board (or spell it out). Students can continue to the next step if they get the word correctly. They must start a new ladder if they do not get it correctly.
- Continue like this and ask students to add as many steps to the ladder as needed. They should start a new ladder if they make a mistake (even if they are near the top).
- 4. First student(s) to the top of the ladder wins!
- 5. After the activity, have students fix any words they spelled incorrectly.

Collaborative Variant

Divide students into pairs and follow a similar approach. Let students choose a word to challenge their classmate. Explain that Student A will say the word for Student B and viceversa.
