## Playtime! Guessing Game

## How to play?

| Level: Elementary |
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| Age: Children (Primary) |
| Time needed: 10 minutes |
| Aim: Review vocabulary for animals and <br> Yes/No questions |

Skills: Vocabulary, Speaking
Materials needed: Coins

## Warm-up Tips

Before playing, ask students to stand up in a circle.
Then say aloud two to four words (animals) and ask them to imitate it. Students can mime and make noises to imitate the given words. Then explain game instructions.

## Instructions: Guessing Game

- Print and cut the vocabulary coins. There is an empty one to use with a different lexical set.
- Divide students into pairs and give each one a set of coins.
- Ask students to pick up a coin and take turns to guess.
- Students will take turns asking yes/no questions to guess the word. Give them a limit of 3-4 questions per turn.
- If students guess the words, they win their classmate's coins.
- The student with the most coins is the winner.


## Follow up Activities

Coins can be used to start a storytelling activity.
Place the coins inside a bag or box. Shake the container and ask a student to take out a coin. Start a short story by giving a brief context and ask the student to continue the story by using the word they got. Repeat until each student has participated.
