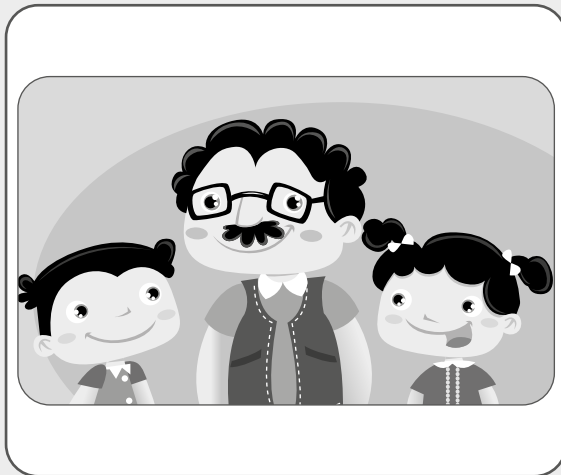
Did you know... that the first Father's Day was celebrated in 1910? It was started to say thank you to all fathers and grandfathers for being so great.
