- 1 Sir Paul McCartney has said that a new and final Beatles song will be available in 2023 using artificial intelligence (AI).
- 2 McCartney did not name the song, but it may be a 1978 Lennon song called 'Now and Then'. It was one of several songs on cassettes with "For Paul" written on them. Lennon made these cassettes just before he died in 1980.
- 3 Lennon recorded the song as he sat at a piano in his New York flat. The lyrics begin, "I know it's true; it's all because of you." They are typical of the love songs Lennon wrote near the end of his life.
- 4 The idea to use AI to make the song came from Peter Jackson's eight-hour film, *Get Back*. For it, editor Emile de la Rey used AI to separate the Beatles' voices from background noise.
- 5 They did the same thing to let McCartney sing with Lennon on his recent tour. McCartney said, "We had John's voice and a piano, and Jackson could separate them with AI. They tell the machine: 'That's the voice. This is a guitar. Lose the guitar."
- 6 'Now and Then' was a possible song for the Beatles to sing in 1995. The three band members who were still alive that year made two of the songs from Lennon's cassettes available – 'Free As A Bird' and 'Real Love'. It was the band's first "new" music in 25 years.
- 7 They also tried to make 'Now and Then', but they didn't finish it. McCartney later said George Harrison didn't want to work on it.
- 8 "It didn't have a very good title, it needed a bit of reworking, but it had a beautiful verse, and it had John singing it," he said. "But George didn't like it." The song on the cassette also had background noise from Lennon's flat.
- 9 McCartney has often said he wanted to finish it.
- 10 The news of the new song comes while more AI music appears online. Hundreds of thousands of people listen to fakes of Drake, the Weeknd and Kanye West before they are removed.

- 11 McCartney said some uses of AI worried him.
- 12 "People will say to me: 'Oh, yeah, there's a track where John's singing one of my songs,' and it's just AI ... It's kind of scary but exciting because it's the future. We'll just have to see where that leads."
