- 1 Fake meat isn't popular. Before, it was seen as one way to fight the climate emergency, but now people aren't interested. Beyond Meat said they lost nearly 31 per cent in the second quarter of this year.
- 2 I'm surprised that we've been in love with fake meat this long. Climate scientists have told us for decades that producing food contributes to global heating. Eating less beef, pork, and chicken is important, creating an opportunity for meat alternative companies. But, according to US charity the Center for Food Safety, eating vegan products is "not the solution" to problems with farming and climate change.
- 3 Recently, we were in love with everything vegan. But there are some problems with it. Eating Beyond Meat products instead of real meat reduced "bad" cholesterol and body weight, said one study. These products might not be harmful, but they are very processed. We don't know the effects of eating them over many years.
- 4 In June 2023, UK vegan company Meatless Farm stopped selling, and sausage company Heck made fewer products. In the US, vegan chicken nugget company Nowadays closed because no one wanted to put money into the company.
- 5 Fake meat can be expensive. Two Beyond Meat burgers cost 4 pounds at Tesco, and four Finest beef burgers are also 4 pounds – the same price for double the amount. Beyond Meat is now lowering prices and cutting jobs.
- 6 The reality is many of these foods don't taste very good. I'm a chef who makes vegan recipes, and I know the taste of fake meat well. Beyond Meat is the closest one to real meat. But if I don't think fake meat tastes better, then why should I eat it?
- 7 My personal rules for eating healthily follow the American author and journalist Michael Pollan's words: "Eat food. Not too much. Mostly plants." This is the simplest thing we can do to eat what is good for our bodies and the planet.

- 8 Whatever you feel about fake meat, these vegan products can help us eat more plants. I believe we want food that tastes like the animal foods we know. So, what will the future be for fake meat?
