- 1 Wider Horizons is an outdoor gathering in Berkshire. Young people (18 to 30 years old) do creative activities like workshops, music, ceremonies and movement. An important part of the weekend is transformation. The poetry workshops used the woodlands as inspiration. I didn't use my phone and my mind was quiet. From the silence, the words came out of me like rainfall. The 2025 event is from 22-28 July. The full price is 250. Jade Serna
- 2 Trigonos is a beautiful and unique retreat centre in Eryri (Snowdonia). Its seven hectares (18 acres) include a tranquil lake. The setting is an important landscape in old Welsh mythology. Storytellers Cath Little and Claire Mace led a weekend workshop for women here. I learned new ideas, improved my own storytelling, and made wise new friends. - 3 At Gladstone's Library, you spend hours reading and writing in a nostalgic book-filled space. Upstairs, you can dream in the book-themed bedrooms.
