Personal details By Nick Southey



Lesson focus: giving and getting information on the telephone

Level: Pre-intermediate and above

Number of students: between two and eight

Time needed: 30-40 minutes

Stages

- 1 Tell students to imagine that they have to buy some life insurance. Ask them what personal details that they expect the insurance company to ask for, e.g phone number, date of birth.
- Write a list of their ideas on the board adding any others that you think are appropriate. Ensure that all the contact information is included phone number, address, e-mail.
- 3 Put students in pairs and ask them to write the questions they would ask to find the different personal information on the list. Bring students together and compare questions.
- 4 Get the students to ask you the questions and write your answers. Make sure they ask you how to spell any word they need. Focus on how you read your e-mail address. Practise more e-mail addresses, paying particular attention to dot (.), at (@), dash (-) and underscore().
- 5 Put the students in pairs. Give each student a copy of the Potential Client form sheet and read the instructions. Give one student in each pair a role card. They role play the conversation starting with the opening line's suggested and then the appropriate question from the boxes below and the information on the card. When they finish, change roles and start again with a different role card.
- 6 Bring students together and ask them to identify the inappropiate question in each question box and draw a line through it. For weaker students, do this stage before the role play.
- Individually, ask the students to write down as many phone numbers and e-mail addresses as they know without looking in their address books or phone. After two minutes, see which students has the most numbers and addresses. He reads out a few examples and the other students write them down. Check they have the correct details on the board.
