ACTIVITY

Individual, groupwork: speaking

AIM

To ask and answer questions about the students' jobs, the company they work for and what their company produces.

GRAMMAR AND FUNCTIONS

Possessives Present simple questions Subject and object pronouns

VOCABULARY

company, produce, beadquarters, operate, president, product, customer, cost, job, work, bours, annual, bolidays, main (= product)

PREPARATION

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

TIME

15 to 25 minutes

PROCEDURE

- 1 Hand out the worksheets.
- 2 Ask the students to complete the questions, using the words in the box below each section.
- 3 Go round checking their work and helping with vocabulary.
- 4 Ask them to write their answers in the space provided on the right. Monitor the answers.
- 5 If necessary, drill the questions.
- Get the students to stand up and circulate, asking each other the questions. Allow ten minutes or so.
- Ask some of the students to report back to the class on the conversations they had.
